

RESET	Press the reset button for 5-7 seconds to restore the device to default factory settings wait approx. 1 minute for the device to reboot (Signal indicator turns green).
Ethernet port	Connect to computers / Ethernet devices, or modem/router using as AP

2.0 Where to place the EM4595 repeater?

The best location to place the EM4595 is approximately half-way between your wireless router and your wireless computer(s) which has/have the weakest wireless reception. This way, the signal strength will be as good as possible. Refer to the following images for an example:

 WEAK	 RECOMMENDED	 EXCELLENT
 Throughput less than 30%	 Throughput up to 60%	 Throughput up to 80%
 Wireless Coverage Extended up to 90%	 Wireless Coverage Extended up to 60%	 Wireless Coverage Extended up to 40%



Hint: Before placing the EM4595 on its destined location, the device needs to be setup. Setting up the EM4595 wireless repeater can be done best, if the EM4595 is located near your wireless router. After setting up the EM4595, you can place the EM4595 at a location defined by using the signal indicator LEDs and the recommended setup as described previously.

3.0 Configure the wireless repeater using the WPS button

1. Please check if your wireless modem/router has a WPS button. Also check whether your wireless router has a properly configured internet connection.
2. Connect the EM4595 to a wall outlet. Please place the EM4595 close to the modem/router during setup.
3. Wait for the LED to turn green.
4. Press the WPS button on your wireless router for approximately 3 seconds*.
5. Now press the WPS button on the EM4595 Wireless Repeater for approximately 5 seconds. Refer to the following image for the WPS button:



6. The connection between your wireless router and the EM4595 wireless repeater will be established automatically (this will take approx. 1 minute including reboot). The smart led indicator will stop flashing and indicate the signal strength. Wait until the WiFi led turns blue.

**Refer to the manual of your wireless router for the exact duration of pressing the WPS button. This can differ from brand or model.*

Note: If the WPS button is used, the SSID and network key are the same as used on your wireless router. Some WPS routers will change their original SSID to another SSID if WPS is used. In this installation guide, the SSID of the wireless router is 'Eminent'.

4.0 Connecting a wireless WPS adapter to the EM4595

1. Press the WPS button on the EM4595 for about 3 seconds.
2. Now press the WPS button on your wireless adapter.
3. The connection between the wireless WPS adapter and EM4595 will be established. Depending on the Windows version you are using, you should see a connected icon in the taskbar.

Note: Some wireless WPS adapters require the use of the supplied software to create a WPS connection. Refer to the manual of your wireless WPS adapter for more information.

5.0 Configuring the EM4595 manually

It is possible to configure the repeater manually instead of using the WPS button.

5.1 Manual configuration

1. Connect the EM4595 to a wall outlet (preferably close to the modem/router).
2. Wait for the signal indicator to turn green. This will take approximately 1 minute.
3. Connect to the EM4595 via Wi-Fi SSID: **Eminent_repeater**, or use the Ethernet cable to connect to the EM4595 directly.
4. Open your internet browser and type `http://192.168.10.1` in your internet browser and then hit Enter.
5. The login screen will appear. Enter the **Username**: "admin" and **Password**: "admin", then click "Log in" to login.



10. Select the corresponding network you want to connect to in the **"Select"** field.
11. Your router's Wi-Fi network name will be shown in the Network Name (SSID) field.
12. Enter the security key of your wireless network in the Pre-Shared Key field.
13. If you want to ensure easy login to your repeater after connecting to your home network, you can select the option Auto configure LAN IP address. Your repeater will now obtain ip address from your router. If you don't change this option the repeaters ip address will remain 192.168.10.1.
14. Click on Save/Apply button.
15. The EM4595 will reboot and connect to your router.
16. You can now connect your wireless network adapter(s) to your repeaters Wi-Fi network name and entering the wireless security key of the wireless network you previously connected.

Note: After the settings have been applied, the EM4595 will reboot. Your device will no longer be connected to the wireless network SSID of the EM4595.

6.0 Access Point mode

1. Connect the EM4595 to a wall outlet (preferably close to the modem/router).
2. Wait for the signal indicator to turn green. This will take approximately 1 minute.
3. Connect to the EM4595 via Wi-Fi SSID: **Eminent_repeater**, or use the Ethernet cable to connect to the EM4595 directly.
4. Open your internet browser and type `http://192.168.10.1` in your internet browser and then hit Enter.
5. The login screen will appear. Enter the **Username**: “**admin**” and **Password**: “**admin**”, then click “Log in” to login.

8. You will notice that the repeater will automatically fill in the default network name from repeater in to Network Name (SSID) field. It is not necessarily needed but we

suggest to rename the network name to: network name + AP so you will always know that you are connected as Access Point.

9. You also have the option to secure the Wi-Fi network by adding a security key. Fill in wireless security code in Key Value field.
10. Click “**Save/Apply**” to confirm. The repeater will reboot and make the changes. This will take approximately 1 minute.
11. Remove the repeater from the power socket.
12. Install your Ethernet cable from modem/router or router into the “**LAN**” port of the repeater.
13. Connect the EM4595 back to the wall outlet.
14. Wait until the “smart led indicator” lights up the three leds. This will take approximately 1 minute.
15. You can now make wireless connection with new made network name (SSID) configured as Access Point.
