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1.0 Introduction

2.0 Download and install the app

Download the app: E-SmartLife from Apple App store or Google Play Store.

2.1 Create account:

1. Tap "**Register**" (or if you already registered "Log in with existing account").
2. Tap "**Agree**"
3. Select country code and enter full national phone number or email address and tap "**Get authentication code**".
4. Check your email or text messages for your authentication code.
5. Enter received authentication code and pick your own password.
6. Tap "**Create location**"
7. Enter location name.
8. Set geographic location by pressing ">"
9. Tap "**Completed**"
10. Tap "**Completed**"

2.2 Add device (QR-Code configuration)

1. Tap on "**Add device**" or "+" (top right corner). A list of potential products appears.
2. Select the device type you want to add from the list
3. Activate the device to be added by plugging it in.
4. Make sure a tone is heard (as shown in example in the application) and tap the button to confirm. If a tone is not heard hold the reset button.
5. Confirm your phone is connected to the Wi-Fi network to which the device will be added, (NOTE !!! The device can only be connected to 2.4 GHz WiFi networks), enter the Wi-Fi password and press "**Confirm**".
6. Read the instructions in the app and tap "**Continue**"
7. Hold the QR code in front of the camera and wait for a confirmation tone to be heard and confirm in the App by tapping the button "**Heard the Beep**" when you have heard the confirmation tone.
8. Now the device will be searched, make sure your phone and the device are close to the router to optimize reception.
9. After the product is found and added, rename it so you can easily recognize it.


If above method fails (this can be due to unstable network or specific network protection) add the device using WiFi Smart configuration by following the steps below.

2.3 Add device (WiFi Smart configuration)

1. Tap on "Add device" or "+" (top right corner). A list of potential products appears.
2. Select the device type you want to add from the list.
3. Tap "Otherwise" (upper right corner)
4. Select "Wi-Fi Smart Configuration"
5. Make sure a tone is heard (as shown in example in the application) and tap the button to confirm. If a tone is not heard hold the reset button.
6. Confirm your phone is connected to the Wi-Fi network to which the device will be added, (NOTE !!! The device can only be connected to 2.4 GHz WiFi networks), enter the Wi-Fi password and press "Confirm".
7. Now the device will be searched, make sure your phone and the device are close to the router to optimize reception.
8. After the product is found and added, rename it so you can easily recognize it.

3.0 App interface:


3.1 Main screen



1. My Home Tap this to select or manage your different locations (e.g. my home, office, etc.) Here you can change
 - Name
 - Rooms
 - Location
 - Device sharing (with other E-SmartLife users)
 - Add location members (to share the devices in a location with other E-SmartLife users)
2. “+” Tap this to add new products (in the selected location), see instructions.
3. Weather information: estimated weather information is shown, based on your set location.
4. Scenes: when creating a scene, it can be selected whether or not to be shown on first page. If they are set to be shown, this is where they will be shown.
5. Rooms: select a room to only show the products that have been assigned to this room. This too quickly find the products relevant for that room.
6. Room management: tap the cog on the right to add or edit rooms Choose a predefined room or enter any custom name and confirm. Tap the newly created room to assign or unassign products to this room. When unassigning, the products are not being removed, but are still available under “All devices”.
7. All installed devices are displayed here. Tap the device to access the device and its settings and options.
8. Main navigation between different displays
 - My location = Device list (main page as mentioned above)
 - Scene = Scenes and Automations
 - Profile = Personal profile and general app settings

3.2 Scenes and Automations

This is where scenes and automations are shown and can be created.



1. Tap “☰” to move or remove current scenes or automations.
 - Changing the order is simply done by sliding vertically
 - Deleting is done by sliding a specific scene or automation to the left and tap “Delete”
2. Tap “+” on the upper right corner to add a new scene or automation, the options for each are described below.
3. Scenes: scenes are created and shown here and can be activated by simply tapping them.
4. Automations: automations are created and shown here

Scenes

A scene is a shortcut to do multiple preset things at once, you can set:

- Name of the scene (also used on main screen as well as by voice assistants commands)
- Image (choose any of the preset images)
- Unlimited number of actions (including enabling or disabling an automation)
- Whether or not to show on first page

On the bottom right of each tile is a small button to edit this specific scene

Automations

Automation is to set one or more actions triggered by one or more events.

Here you can set the following:

- Name (used on main screen as well as by voice assistants commands)
- Image (choose any of the preset images)
- Type of conditions (only applicable when combining multiple conditions as trigger)
 - When ALL set conditions are met
 - When ANY of the set conditions are met

The following conditions can be selected:

- Any notification from a sensor, detector or camera
- Any state of a product which is set manually or automatically
- A specific time of day (which can be repeated on selected days)


- The sunrise or sunset
- Weather conditions (these are approximates based on your set location)

Each condition can simple be removed by sliding it to the left and tapping **“Delete”**

Actions to be executed can be:

- Activating a scene
- Activating another automation (to enable or disable an existing automation)
- Switching a product on/off
- Set a lighting product to a certain mode, brightness or temperature

Example: You can set a scene for the IP camera to turn on a Plug-in power switch when motion is detected and turn off again after 10 seconds



4.0 Profile

Here you can set and check the basic information of your profile.

1. Home management (Add or edit set locations)
2. Message center (showing all notifications of cameras with a corresponding picture, sensors or detectors)
3. Scan QR code (only required in case of emergency)
4. Feedback (please send us your feedback, both positive and negative)
5. Settings
 - a. Enable/disable sound of notifications while in the app
 - b. Enable/disable App message notifications
 - c. About (here you can give us your rating, find version information and manually check for updates)
 - d. Empty cache memory to free up disk space (this will however result in a temporary slower interaction as interfaces need to be reloaded)

5.0 Product page

5.1 Product menu

Tap the button on the upper right corner on the product page. Through this menu you can do the following (depends on the type of product)

- a. Change the product name
- b. Set device sharing to give other people access to this product, for this location members need to be added
- c. Create a product group to control multiple similar products at once.

Cameras only:

- d. Basic feature setting where you can switch status indicator, watermark, audio mode or flip the image for ceiling mounted camera.
- e. Sound detection can be switched on/off and the sensitivity can be set
- f. Motion detection can be switched on/off and the sensitivity can be set
- g. Storage can be monitored or formatted
